This is an exciting time for the residents of the City of Tustin as construction begins on our new 32,000 square foot library facility. The new building will be more than twice the size of the existing library building.

Construction is expected to take approximately 18 months. The orientation of the building is being changed to facilitate easier access for the public and parking will be increased.

The Tustin Branch Library is operated by the Orange County Public Library under a lease agreement with the City. The Tustin Branch is one of the busiest in the Orange County Public Library system—serving as many as 1,000 people daily.

In defining the need for a new Tustin Library, the City worked closely with the Orange County Public Library staff and welcomed input from students, parents, Friends of the Library, volunteers and business people within the community.
