#### **Santa Ana Crimes of Interest for October:**

- For the month of October crime remained low in the unincorporated Santa Ana area. Vehicle burglaries require force entry (e.g., broken window, pried door lock) into the vehicle and the grand and petty thefts from a vehicle resulted in the vehicle being unlocked or unsecured during the commission of the crime. Of the three vehicle thefts; one was from an unsecured vehicle, one was where property was removed from the bed of a truck and the last was where wheels were removed.
  - ◆ Self awareness and safety precautions remain the same:
    - ◆ There is no particular area of Santa Ana that is being targeted, therefore; each resident should be responsible for keeping their vehicles locked and valuables out of plain view so they do not become the next victim.
    - ◆ Always be aware of your surroundings and report any suspicious activity you may see in your neighborhood to the Orange County Sheriff's Dept.
- A total of 5 residential thefts (PC 487/488) occurred in the last month, a decrease from the 6 that occurred in September. One of the burglaries was during an open house, two were from when the residents left their garage doors open, one through a rear slider (unknown if locked) and one with an unknown entry point.(Streets included were, Tustin Pines Way, Panorama Place, Skyline Drive, Grovemont and Coronel)
- It is important that your residence is locked at all times, is well lit on the outside (motion sensor lights), the curtains or blinds are drawn, and it's secured with a burglary alarm, while you are away from your residence.

#### Tustin Crimes of Interest for October:

- One residential burglary (PC 487) occurred on 10-7-2011 at about 0930 hours on the 1900 block of Calle Roja. The suspect removed jewelry from a combination safe w/o forced entry.
- One vehicle theft (PC488) occurred.
  - A vehicle was parked on a residential street outside of a residence located on the 1900 block of Bent Twig Lane. Sometime between 10-28-2011 at 2345 hours and 10-29-2011 at 0845 hours the suspect(s) entered the **unsecured** vehicle and removed property (**Purse, wallet, ID and DVD's**).
