## Analysis and concerns:

- There was one commercial burglary (PC 459C) at Hewes Middle School, suspect removed \$5 from a teacher's desk.
- There were four residential burglaries (PC 459R):
  - 13000 block of Prospect Avenue, a stove was taken from a vacant home with a lock box.
  - 11000 block of Hunting Horn Drive, suspect smashed rear door to gain entry, loss of costume jewelry.
  - 13000 block of Ethelbee Way, suspect smashed the rear door to gain entry, loss of two guns, a gun safe, a camera, jewelry and two vehicle keys.
- There were two incidents of grand theft (PC 487):
  - 12000 block of Circula Panorama, money was taken from a purse inside the residence. Victim believes the suspect is the AT&T tech that was working in the home.
  - 10000 block of Hideaway Lane, multiple sunglasses, jewelry and an inhaler were taken from an unlocked vehicle.
- There were five petty thefts (PC 488):
  - 13000 block of Sandhurst Place, sunglasses, gift cards and a bag were removed from an unlocked vehicle.
  - 12000 block of Palomar Way, numerous items were taken from an open garage.
  - At Foothill High School, an unattended iphone charger was taken from a desk.
  - At the 10000 block of Crawford Canyon Road, a purse was removed from an unlocked vehicle parked on the driveway.
  - At the 10000 block of Crawford Canyon Road, the key which was taken previously was used to removed and iphone charger from the vehicle.
- There were five incidents of vandalism (PC 594):
  - 9000 block of Brentwood Drive, a rear vehicle window was smashed.
  - 10000 block of Boca Canyon Drive, a rear vehicle window was smashed.
  - Graffiti was found at Foothill High School.
  - 12000 block of Malena Drive, the rear vehicle window was smashed.
  - Graffiti was found at the 17000 block of Whitney Drive.
- There were two stolen vehicles (VC 10851):
  - 18000 block of Casselle Avenue, victim believes it was his son.
  - 12000 block of Barrett Lane, a locked vehicle was taken.

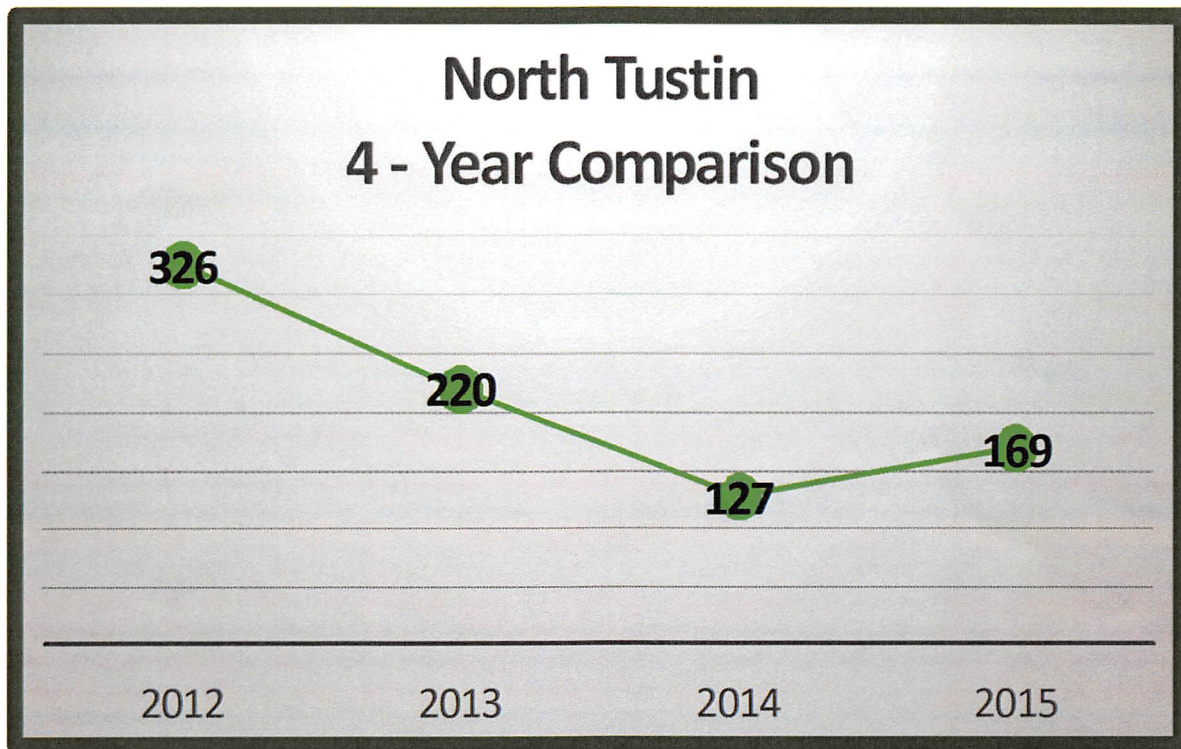

### Analysis and concerns:

- There were two residential burglaries (PC 459R):

  - 1000 block of Ravencrest Road, suspect smashed the rear slider to gain entry, loss of collectable coins.
- There was one vehicle burglary (PC 459V) on the 13000 block of Ponderosa Street, the vehicle was unlocked and the key was in the vehicle.

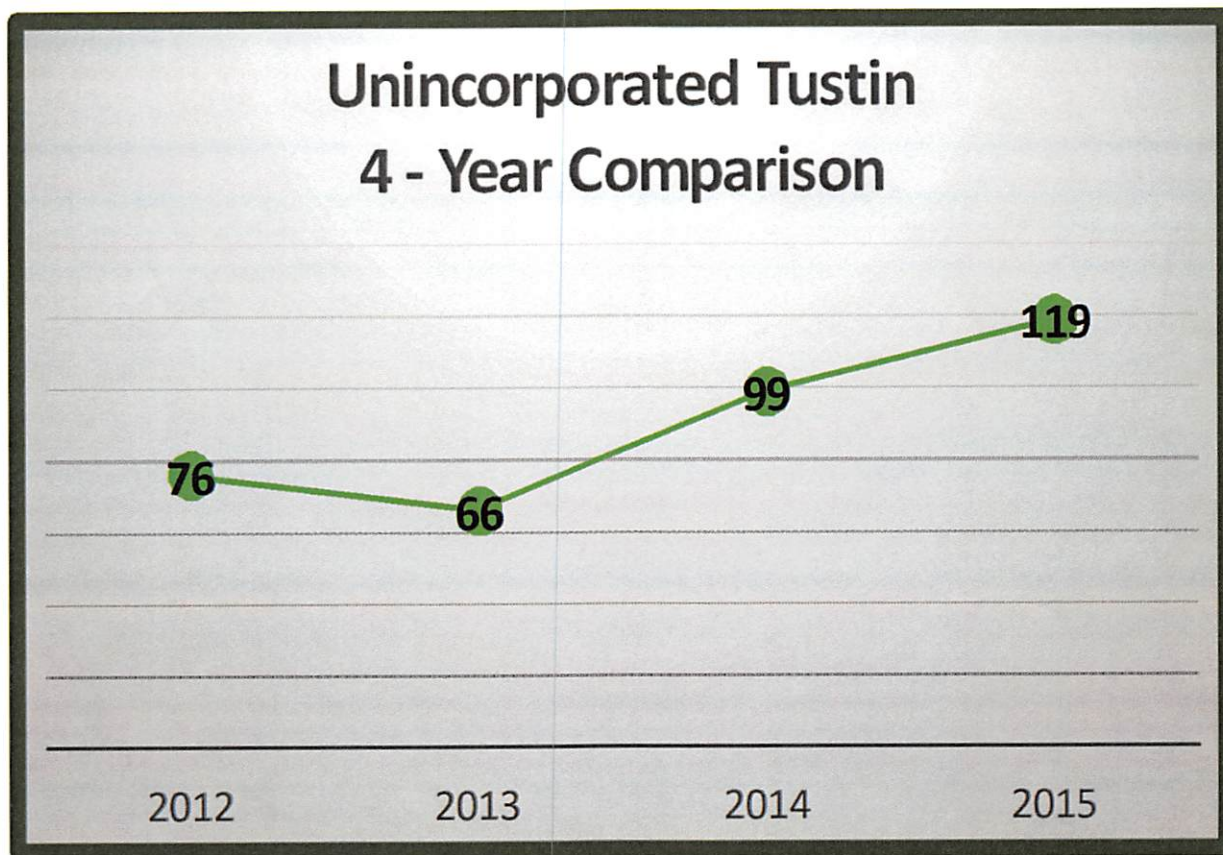
