Analysis and concerns:

- There were three residential burglaries (PC 459R):
 - 12000 block of Vista Panorama, suspects broke the door to gain entry, took some miscellaneous items and broke multiple items in the residence.
 - 10000 block of Crawford Canyon Road, suspect entered through the **unlocked** back door and removed keys and two credit cards from a purse.
 - 1500 block of Clearview Lane, suspect entered through a rear bedroom door, loss of jewelry.
- There were two vehicle burglaries (PC 459V):
 - 11000 block of Hyde Park Drive, suspect smashed the window to take a backpack which was **left on the front seat**.
 - 18000 block of Lassen Drive, construction tools were taken from a truck, unknown method of entry.
- There were three incidents of vandalism (PC 594):
 - 19000 block of Dodge at Foothill High School, there was an incident involving graffiti.
 - 12000 block of Fairhaven, suspect put a hole in a window of a home.
 - 13000 block of Lindale Lane, the front door of a residence was broken.
- There were three stolen vehicles (VC 10851):
 - 13000 block of Shepard Way, a vehicle was taken.
 - 10000 block of Crawford Canyon, a locked vehicle was taken from a residential driveway.
 - 13000 block of Sussex Place, a locked vehicle was taken from a residential driveway.

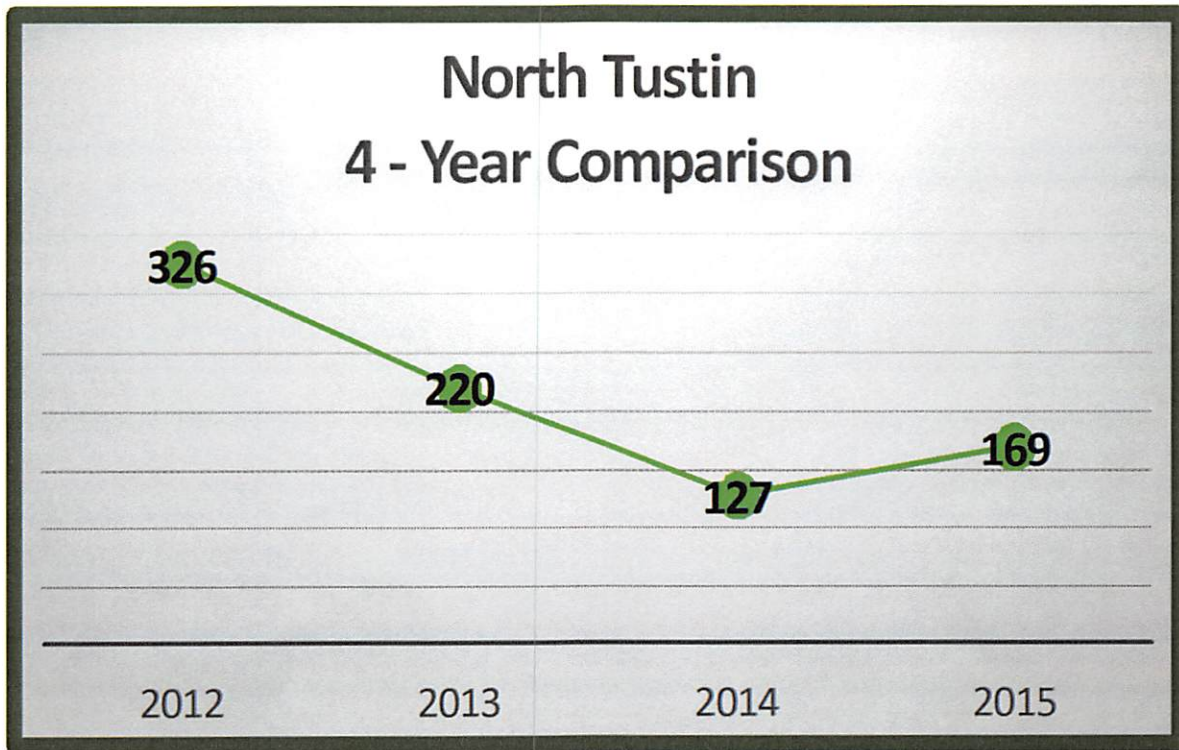

UNINCORPORATED TUSTIN - MONTHLY CRIME TRENDS

Analysis and concerns:

- There was one residential burglary (PC 459R) on the 11000 block of Las Palmas Drive; it was an **unsecured** home that was under construction. Loss of tools.
- There were two vehicle burglaries (PC 459V):
 - 1400 block of Stockbridge Road, suspect entered the rear hatch of the vehicle and took an ID, Flashlight, glasses, cleaning supplies and a gun.
 - 1900 block of Park Skyline, sunglasses, cash and jewelry were taken from an **unlocked** vehicle parked on a residential driveway.
- There was one attempted vehicle burglary (PC 459V) on the 1800 block of Rainbow Drive. The rear window was smashed, the suspects fled when a neighbor's porch light flickered on and off.
- There was one incident of grand theft (PC 487) on the 17000 block of Norwood Park Place. **Unsecured** painting equipment and bikes were removed from the driveway.
- There was one petty theft (PC 488) on the 18000 block of Lerner Lane, a laptop and purse were taken from an **unlocked** vehicle parked on a residential driveway.
- There were two incidents of vandalism (PC 594)
 - On the 18000 block of Warren Avenue, suspect threw eggs and stomped on the roof of a vehicle.
 - 13000 block of Ponderosa, the front door of a business was pried open, no loss.

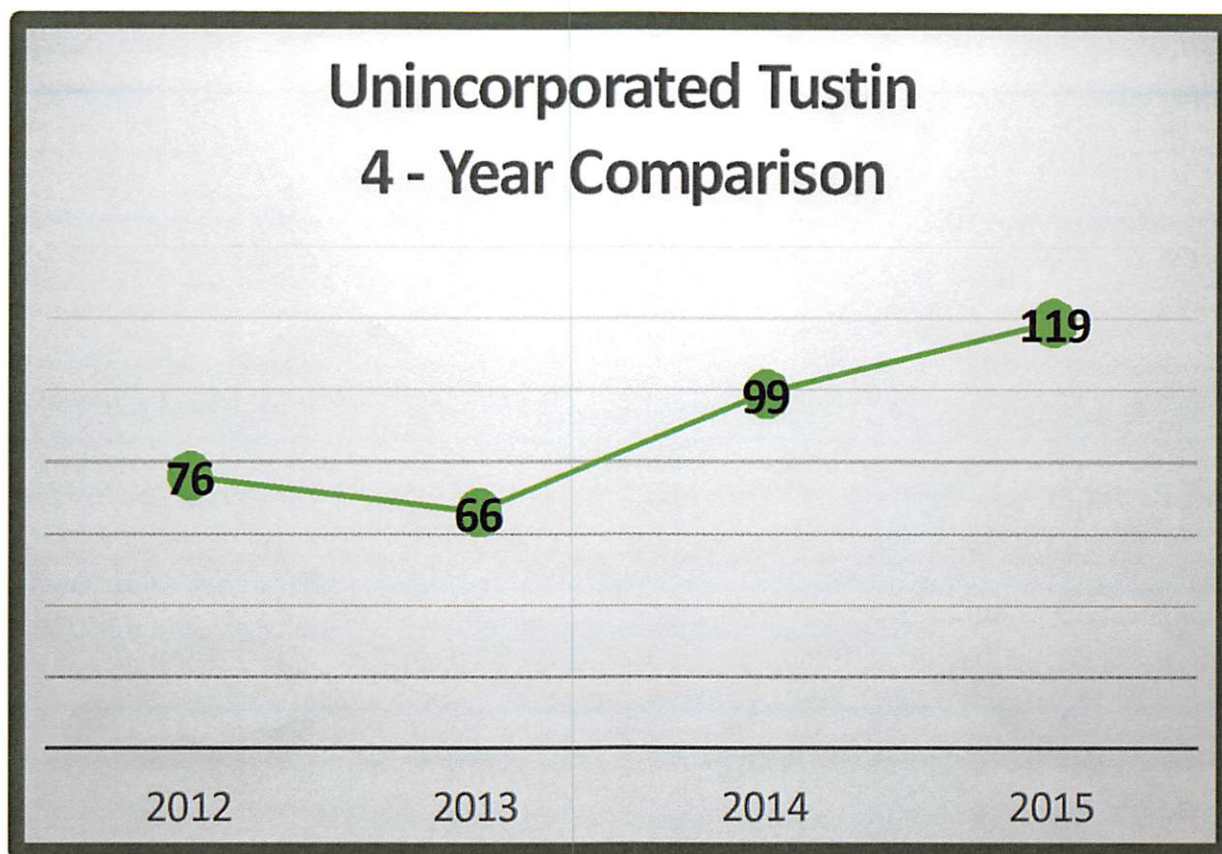
