
Analysis and concerns:

- There was one attempted residential burglary (PC 664/459R) on the 18000 block of Beachmont Avenue. Suspect attempted to pry open the French doors unsuccessfully, the alarm was triggered.
- There were five residential burglaries (PC 459R):
 - 12000 block of Larchwood Lane, victim's house was under construction, suspect
 pushed in the rear French doors, which <u>did not have a lock</u> installed yet. Loss of
 power tools.
 - 10000 block of Furlong Drive, unknown method of entry, victim away on vacation, upon return, he realized jewelry was missing.
 - 12000 block of Fairhaven, suspected entered the property though an open driveway gate, then into the residence through a back window. Loss of jewelry.
 - 11000 block of Hunting Horn, suspect entered though an <u>unlocked</u> rear slider, loss of jewelry.
 - 1300 block of Arroyo Lindo, victims were away on vacation, left the side garage door <u>unlocked</u> for cleaner. Suspect rummaged through the two vehicles parked inside and also broke the door to the residence. No loss was noted at this time.
- There was one vehicle burglary (PC 459V) on the 12000 block of Vista Panorama, a vehicle's window was smashed, loss of a knife, phone adapter and cologne.
- There were three incidents of petty theft (PC 488):
 - 12000 block of Vista Panorama, suspect entered <u>unlocked</u> vehicle door and took a checkbook.
 - 1000 block of Timberline, suspect took two packages from the front of the house.
 - 10000 block of Ambervale a purse and two pairs of sunglasses were taken from an **unlocked** vehicle.
- There were five incidents of vandalism (PC 594):
 - 12000 block of Red Hill, suspect struck a mailbox with a bat.
 - 2000 block of E 17th Street suspect threw a rock at a store front.
 - 18000 block of Lassen Drive, suspect entered school grounds and scratched five windows (Prentice School).
 - 13000 block of Sandhurst suspect spray painted a vehicle's interior and exterior. Vehicle's window was down.
 - 12000 block of Dunas Road, a vehicle was scratched and tires were deflated. Victim knew the suspect.
- There was one stolen vehicle (VC 10851) on the 16000 block of Harbor, vehicle was taken from an apartment building parking lot.


Analysis and concerns:
